

## Challenge

Field sales and service staff at numerous locations would input data into a six-megabyte spreadsheet, send the document to its Sandusky, OH, operation, where employees there would then consolidate information from the individual spreadsheets — a time-consuming and cumbersome procedure. Files would often become corrupted when users made changes, further complicating the data-capturing process.

The company had considered developing a software solution internally. But when management saw a Shop-Trak demo, team members loved the product. JBT Corporation requested an enhancement to accommodate remote time entry. Since then, the remote time entry functionality has been incorporated into the standard Shop-Trak product to meet the needs of other clients.
